**Suprep Bowel Prep - Split Dose**

**DAY BEFORE THE COLONOSCOPY (First Dose):**

- Drink only clear liquids for breakfast, lunch and dinner.

**Approved Clear Liquids:**

Water  
Strained fruit juices **WITHOUT** pulp (apple, white grape, lemonade)  
Clear broth or bouillon (chicken or beef)  
Carbonated or noncarbonated clear soft drinks  
Gatorade, Kool-aid or other fruit drinks (no RED or PURPLE)  
Plain Jell-O without fruit or toppings (no RED or PURPLE)

- **NO SOLID FOOD, MILK or MILK PRODUCTS**
- Complete steps 1-4 using (1) 6 ounce bottle of solution starting at **5 pm.**
- You may continue drinking clear liquids until you go to bed.

Step 1 - Pour ONE (1) six ounce bottle of SUPREP liquid into the mixing container.  
Step 2 - Add cool drinking water to the 16 ounce line on the container and mix.  
Step 3 - Drink ALL the liquid in the container.  
Step 4 - You must drink two (2) more 16 ounce containers of water over the next 1 hour.

**MORNING OF THE COLONOSCOPY (Second Dose):**

- Repeat and complete steps 1-4 using (1) six ounce bottle of solution starting at **5 am.**
- Be sure to complete ALL 4 steps in this dose (don't forget the water!)
- Once finished with the 2nd dose of the prep completely, take nothing by mouth until after your procedure.
- You may take heart, blood pressure, seizure or thyroid medications the day of your procedure with a sip of water. No diabetic meds.

- You will need to bring a driver to take you home.
- Sedation will be administered intravenously for the procedure, therefore you **MUST** have someone to drive you home. You may **NOT** go home by bus or taxi.

### **POST PROCEDURE INSTRUCTIONS**

1. If the physician obtained biopsies please allow 7-10 days to be contacted with the results.
2. If the physician prescribed a new medication for you please contact the pharmacy to review the status of this as some medications may need a prior authorization from your insurance company and this process may take up to two weeks.
3. If the physician has recommended an office follow up or repeat endoscopy and you have not heard from Midlands Clinic GI department in 7-10 days please call the office at 605-217-5517.
